Disney Descendants Dancing

June 8th-12th

In this camp students will explore jazz and ballet dance Disney Descendants style! They will work on learning an entire dance throughout the week that will be showcased for the parents on the last day of camp. Costume dress up, crafts and daily games will bring the magic to life! Students should wear plain colored dance clothes (such as leggings and form fitting shirt) and have dance shoes, preferably jazz shoes although ballet shoes will also work. Students should also bring a water bottle and a snack each day.

Preschool "Super Pets" Dance Camp

In this camp students will explore ballet and tap dance within the theme of Super Pets. They will get the opportunity to dress up, read stories, do crafts and dance to music galore! Students leotards with tights or leggings, shorts and fitted plain athletic tops, ballet shoes and tap shoes. Boys may wear a plain shirt and athletic shorts with ballet shoes and tap shoes. Students should also bring a water bottle. A daily snack will be provided; if your student has a food allergy please indicate upon registration.

Intermediate Dance Intensive

For students enrolled in Ballet IV and V for Spring 2025

Intermediate/Advanced students will gain the opportunity to hone their technique during this intensive. Students will take ballet and do choreography every day, have a snack break and then a rotating third class to extend their classical dance training that may include modern, jazz, contemporary, dance history, anatomy/physiology and choreography. Students will learn one dance that will have the opportunity to perform alongside the Advanced Intensive at a theatre performance on Saturday, June 27th.

For students enrolled in Ballet VI and VII/VIII for Spring 2026

*Required for Current Ballet VI and VII/VIII students auditioning for Nutcracker in Fall of 2026 unless prior arrangements have been made with the Directors.

Advanced students will gain the opportunity to hone their technique, explore aspects of dance artistry focusing on the opportunity to learn as a student choreographer and prepare for the upcoming auditions and Fall season. Students will take ballet and pointe regularly followed by classes in other rotating aspects/styles of dance such as precision jazz, acting, variations, and mental health. Students will learn at least 2 pieces of choreography, as well as choosing to participate in the student choreographer projects as both choreographers and performers. These pieces will be performed in a theatre performance on Saturday, June 27th. Field trips will be a part of the experience as well which may, but not necessarily include theater management, tech and performance. Students should bring snacks and a pre packed lunch every day.
