Preschool Under the Sea Camp

June 12th-15th

9-11am Monday-Thursday in Studio B

In this camp students will explore ballet and tap dance within the theme of under the sea! They will get the opportunity to dress up, read stories, do crafts and dance to music galore! Students will need black or pink leotards with pink tights, pink ballet shoes and black tap shoes. Boys may wear a white shirt and black shorts with black ballet shoes (with white or black socks) and black tap shoes. Students should also bring a water bottle. A daily snack will be provided; if your student has a food allergy please indicate upon registration.

Intermediate/Advanced Dance Intensive

June 12-16th

9am-1pm Monday-Friday in Studio A

For students enrolled in Ballet IV and V for Spring 2023

Intermediate/Advanced students will gain the opportunity to hone their technique during this intensive. Students will take ballet every day, followed by a snack break and then a rotating second and third class to extend their classical dance training that may include modern, jazz, contemporary, dance history, anatomy/physiology and choreography.

Pinocchio Musical Theatre Camp

June 19-24th

9am-1:30pm Monday-Friday in Studio A with Rehearsal and Performance on Saturday

Taught by a working professional in the world of theatre arts; students in this camp will get the opportunity to sing, dance and act! Throughout the week they will learn a fully scripted one act musical "Pinocchio". This production includes a full script, song and dance. Students will perform Pinocchio alongside the Advanced Dance Intensive on Saturday, June 24th at the Scoundrel and Scamp Theatre located in Downtown Tucson. Students should wear plain colored dance clothes (such as leggings and form fitting shirt) and have dance shoes, preferably jazz shoes although ballet shoes will also work. Students should also bring a water bottle and a snack each day. Certain props and/or costume pieces may be required in addition to camp and be the responsibility of the student to obtain accordingly.

*Required for **Ballet VI** and VII/VIII students auditioning for Nutcracker in Fall of 2023 unless prior arrangements have been made with the Directors

Advanced students will gain the opportunity to hone their technique, explore aspects of dance artistry and prepare for the upcoming auditions and Fall season. Students will take ballet and pointe daily followed by classes in other rotating aspects/styles of dance such as contemporary ballet, anatomy and physiology and dance history.

Students will learn and perform a one act ballet in addition to at least one other style of dance at their performance on Saturday. The performance will occur at the Scoundrel and Scamp Theatre located in downtown Tucson.

Field trips will be a part of the experience as well which may, but not necessarily, include cross training in ballroom dance and/or aerial arts or participating in a dance film. Students should bring snacks and a pre packed lunch every day.
